

## Do's

### DO

use the machines on which you have been trained because safety is more important than experimentation



### DO

always wear safety equipment as it goes without saying



### DO

always wear appropriate clothing

### DO

disconnect the power before any blade changes



### DO

use sharp blades, this might sound like common sense, but people often miss on this. So, make sure your blades and tools are sharp



## Don'ts

### DON'T

wear loose clothing or loose work gloves. Also, don't wear any bracelets or rings and anything else that could potentially get caught in a moving machine

### DON'T

get distracted when you're in the middle of using a woodworking tool

### DON'T

leave a running machine unattended

### DON'T

get bogged down in excessive detail and keep everything simple

### DON'T

remove sawdust or cuttings by hand
