Tools & Technologies

Mason

√ Trowels

These are triangular shaped heads attached on wooden/plastic handles. These are used to spread mortar on bricks.



√ Chisels

These are used to cut bigger bricks into smaller pieces. One can also use this to remove bricks. This is a flat object with a sharp object.



√ Hammers

These are not the daily or commonly used hammers, it comes with an iron head. These are square shaped and are quite heavier than the normal hammer weighing up to 3 pounds mainly used for splitting bricks.



√ Jointers

Flat bent metal in the middle are the most common jointers. These are used to make mortar joints.



√ Squares

In order to measure right angles and lay corners masons use a square. It can be made of both wood and metal and come in different sizes.



Levels

These are used to identify level lines and plumb which are horizontal and vertical, respectively. These have vials inside a glass and has a bubble of air suspended liquid. In order to identify a perfect level, one just must observe the bubble in the center of the two lines in the glass.
