

Picking is the process that occurs after an order is placed from an online store. It is done using a picking list, for finding the proper quantities of each product from its respective location in the warehouse.

Picker Should Possess:

- Proficient with using tools required for picking
- Working knowledge of computer
- Physically agile and should be able to lift heavy packages
- Excellent organizational skills



Responsibilities of Picker:

- 👍 Ensuring work areas are kept clean, neat, and, well-organized
- 👍 Packing incoming stock away, taking inventory and reporting shortages or damage
- 👍 Keeping records of all shipments
- 👍 Picking orders as requested by management
- 👍 Sealing and tagging containers, confirming the accuracy of orders, and signing pick tickets to confirm
- 👍 Ensuring correct shipping information is attached and moving completed orders to the shipping area
- 👍 Placing containers on pallets, and securing with stretch wrap, shrink wrap, and strapping
- 👍 Loading and unloading trucks by using totes, jacks, and forklifts

7 ways to pick:

| ● Single line orders | Single SKU per order, multiple orders |
| ● One order at a time | One order multi-line |
| ● Cart/Bin | Multiple orders sorted as they are picked |
| ● Batch pick & sort | Separate sort function |
| ● Zone pick | Items are separated by zones and picked in that zone |
| ● Zone pick and combine | Separate zone batches are merged at or before packing |
| ● Pick and pass | Order is picked to conveyor or cart and pushed to next zone |
